What BIG IDEAS will you cover in this topic? The process of geographical fieldwork. This is something which will be recapped in year 8 and will be done if students continue geography at GCSE. Understanding why we would cover fieldwork in geography. In order to answer a question about the world. Students will investigate the environmental quality of various sites around the school grounds and compare them to each other.	What other <u>key concepts, knowledge and skills</u> will you learn in this topic? Continue our ability to read and use a map by using one of the school grounds in order to find locations. Understanding how to present data and draw a graph showing this information.

Where does this topic fit into the <u>curriculum plan</u> for this subject? This is the sixth and final topic in year 7 geography.
