<p>What BIG IDEAS will you cover in this topic?</p> <p>This topic introduces the religion of Islam, focusing on key beliefs such as the Five Pillars. We will also explore the concept of Islamophobia — what it is, why it happens, and how it can be challenged — to help build understanding and respect for others.</p>	<p>What other <u>key concepts, knowledge and skills</u> will you learn in this topic?</p> <p>Gain an understanding of the basic beliefs of Islam and how these beliefs shape the daily lives of Muslims.</p> <p>Develop the ability to explain the Five Pillars and reflect on their importance through written assessment.</p> <p>Build skills in analysis, empathy, and respectful discussion of religious and social issues.</p>
<p>What important <u>prior knowledge</u> will you use from your prior learning?</p> <p>This will vary depending on your primary school experience, but any prior learning about world religions, belief systems, or community values will be helpful.</p> <p>Where does this topic fit into the <u>curriculum plan</u> for this subject?</p> <p>This is the fourth unit in our curriculum and the third world religion we will study this year, following our exploration of other major faiths.</p>	<p>Assessment: How and when will you be assessed on this topic? End of Unit Test focusing on knowledge.</p> <p>What will the success criteria be?</p> <p>Success will be demonstrated through a written, essay-style response that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clearly explains each of the Five Pillars. Uses accurate terminology and correct spelling. Includes thoughtful analysis of which Pillar you believe is the most important, and why. Shows your ability to support your ideas with well-reasoned arguments and examples.
