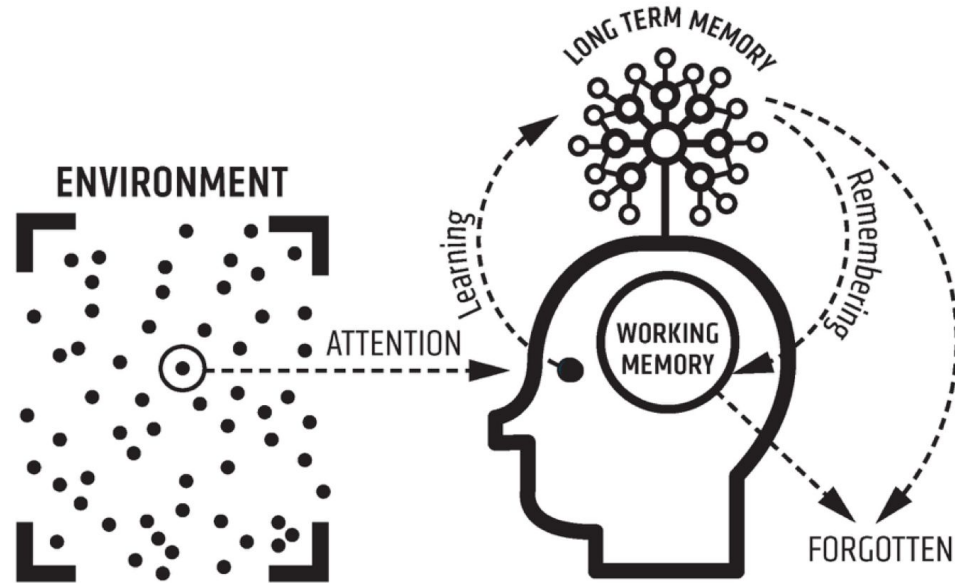

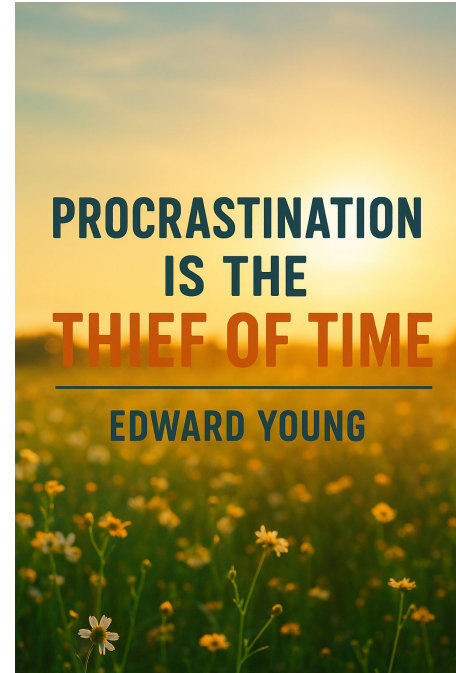

Audit - where do your strengths and weaknesses lie?

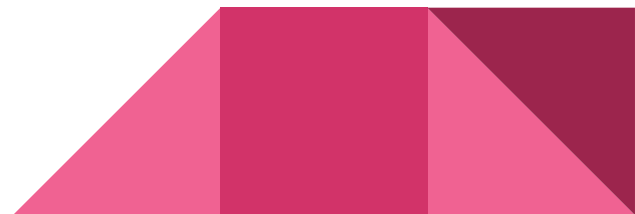
