Possessive adjectives

Possessive adjectives are the words for 'my', 'your', 'his', 'her', etc.

These words agree in number with the noun they are describing:

	singular	plural
my	mi hermano	mis hermanos
your	tu hermano	tus hermanos
his/her	su hermano	sus hermanos

Adjectives

Adjectives describe nouns. Their endings change to agree with the noun they describe.

Adjectives fall into three main groups:

- ending in -o or -a
- ending in -e
- ending in a consonant.

	singular		plural	
	masculine	feminine	masculine	feminine
ending in -o	pequeño	pequeña	pequeños	pequeñas
ending in -e	inteligente	inteligente	inteligentes	Inteligentes
ending in a consonant	azul	azul	azules	azules

Note: **joven** (young) adds an accent in the plural to keep the same sound: **jóvenes**.

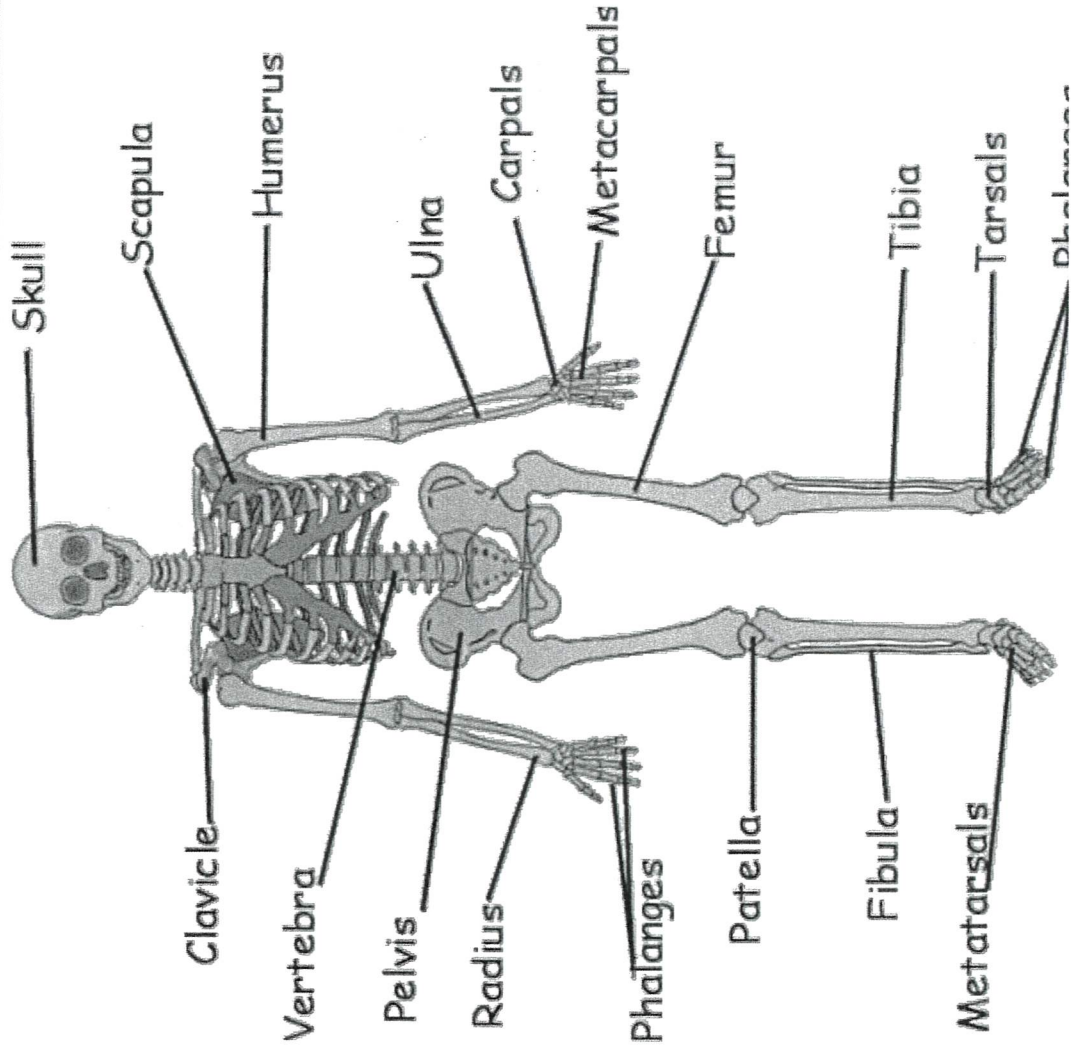
