Topic: Content Area 7: Partnership working in health and social care



What BIG IDEAS will you cover in this topic?

In this content area you will learn about partnership working, potential barriers to partnership working and how partnership working can meet the needs of individuals.

Powerful knowledge: what important prior knowledge will you use from your prior learning?

You have already developed a strong understanding of the different types, purposes, and functions of health and social care provision and services. You have also explored the various job roles within the sector, along with the key legislation, policies, and procedures that guide professional practice. You have studied human lifespan development. You have considered how care needs change across different stages of life and how services can support individuals at each stage. You have learned about the different types of referrals used to access health and social care services, as well as the various barriers that individuals may face when trying to access these services. You will now consider partnership working and how this meets the needs of individuals, you will explore the barriers to partnership working.

Where does this topic fit into the curriculum plan for this subject?

You have already studied Content Area 1,2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. You are now studying Content Area 7.

You will also consider the potential barriers that may affect successful partnership working, such as poor communication or lack of resources, and the strategies that can be used to overcome these barriers to improve outcomes for individuals.
