There are new benchmark criteria from 2017 which the government use to measure the successes of schools in England. One of these is the number of students who attain a 'standard pass' or a 'strong pass' in both English and Mathematics. At WCHS, we are immensely pleased with the attainment of our students against this measure and also just how much this result has risen in recent years.
